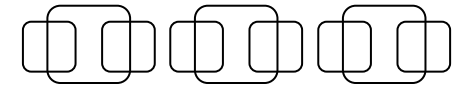
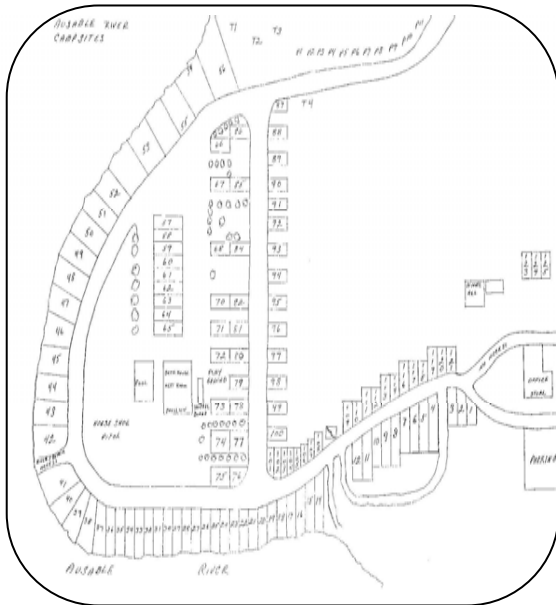

Rules & Regulations

RULES AND REGULATIONS TO BE FOLLOWED BY ALL CAMPERS AND THEIR GUESTS.

- 1) **THERE IS NO LIFE GUARD AT THE POOL OR RIVER. NO CHILD IS TO SWIM OR BE IN POOL GATES WITHOUT A SUPERVISING ADULT. They are never to be left alone.**
- 2) **Quiet hours** are 11 pm to 8 am. All children under 14 must be back at their campsites by 9 pm. **NO BIKES AFTER DARK.** Bicycle helmets are a New York State Law. Please accompany children under 18 years old to restrooms after 11 pm. Please DO NOT let your child play in the playground before 8 am.
- 3) **For your safety,** please be extremely careful with lit cigarettes, fires, and matches. Please light fires only in designated areas. Please do not move fire rings and never leave them unattended. THERE ARE NO FIREARMS OR GUNS OF ANY KIND ALLOWED. NO FIREWORKS INCLUDING SPARKLERS.
- 4) **Speed limit is 5 mph and is strictly enforced.**
- 5) **No Motor scooters, mini bikes, mopeds or ATV vehicles.**
- 6) **Loud and abusive language and aggressive behavior** will not be tolerated at any time and is cause for eviction from the campground, without refund.
- 7) **CAMPGROUND REFUSE -** All garbage must be placed INTO the dumpsters located along the main road of the campground. There is no curbside service. Household garbage is not to be placed in trash cans by pavilion. All recyclables must be placed in the proper provided cans as required by the New York Law. No appliances, metal, oil, batteries, or tires will be accepted - they must be disposed of off campground.
- 8) **PETS:** Always have your dog on a leash. Always pick up after your animals. Please be considerate of others, no pets in laundry rooms, bathrooms, pool area or playground. All owners are responsible for their pets and those of their guests. No Rotweillers, Doberman Pinchers or Pit Bulls.
- 9) **All Campers** are responsible for their guests, their guests children, and their guests pets.

Camping/Rental Fees

Cabin rentals:

All are on wooded sites and have a covered deck, one is on the river. Each cabin has electric ceiling fan with light, small refrigerator, microwave, picnic table and a fire ring.

Not provided are linens, cooking, and cleaning supplies.

4 person cabin	\$60.00/day	\$360.00/week
6 person cabin	\$60.00/day	\$360.00/week

Trailer rentals:

Each sleeps 4-6 people. The rental fee includes water, electric, full camper bathroom, full kitchen utensils, microwave, hot water, heat, some with air conditioner, picnic table and fire ring.

Not provided are linens and cleaning supplies.

Deposits are required. Reservation Cancellations without 7 days notice & NO Shows will be charged a one night fee.

A \$50.00 damage deposit is required at Check-In.

Camping fees: You may have one (1) camper/RV and one (1) tent or two (2) tents on each site. A pop-up is considered a camper, NOT a tent.

Primitive Tent Sites	\$24.00/day	\$144.00/week	\$432.00/month
Full Hook-up: Off River	\$28.00/day	\$168.00/week	\$504.00/month
Full Hook-up: On River	\$35.00/day	\$210.00/week	\$630.00/month

Check-In is 1:00 PM. Check-out is 11:00 AM.

There is an extra charge for more than 4 individuals.

Camp fee includes two (2) car passes per site

*** SEASONAL RATES AVAILABLE UPON REQUEST ***

VISITOR FEE: ALL visitors (adults & children) must STOP at Office to register and pay fee **BEFORE** entering campsite.

**** NO** visitors are to enter campground after **9:00 PM!!****

DAY - \$3.00 per person - must leave by **10:00 PM**

OVERNIGHT - \$5.00 per person.

Pets must have certification of rabies/distemper shots & be approved and registered at time of check-in.
